This Month in Labor History 2011 UK public sector strikes



The proposed pension reforms prompted wide anger among public sector workers, many of whom say they are bearing the brunt of austerity measures imposed to try to rein in Britain's deficit.

The strike actions resulted in disruption of services including:

- 19,000 out of 21,700 schools in England closed or partially closed.
 - 6,000 out of 30,000 non-urgent medical operations cancelled.
- 135,000 civil servants on strike, representing just over a quarter of the civil service.
- The Department for Education said 58% of 21,700 state schools in England were closed, with 13% of these partially shut down. In Scotland just 30 of the 2,700 council run schools remained open. In Wales around 80% were believed shut and in Northern Ireland more than 50% of 1,200 schools were closed.

The strike saw walkouts by tens of thousands of border agency staff, probation officers, radiographers, librarians, job centre staff, court staff, social workers, refuse collectors, midwives, road sweepers, cleaners, school meals staff, paramedics, tax inspectors, customs officers, passport office staff, police civilian staff, driving test examiners, patent officers and health and safety inspectors.

In Wales, unions reported around 170,000 workers on strike and, in Scotland, around 300,000. Up to 1,000 marches and rallies took place across the UK.

Union leaders say it is unfair to expect public sector workers to pay more into their pensions, work longer and accept worse terms for their pensions.

Brendan Barber, General Secretary of the Trades Union Congress, said the unions were "sending a crystal clear message to the government that we are strong, that we are united, and that our campaign will go on until we secure justice and fairness for every public servant."



JOHN DEERE

About 10,000 members of the United Auto Workers union went on strike against farm and construction equipment maker John Deere at 12:01 10/14/2021.

The UAW had reached a tentative agreement on a new six-year contract with the company two weeks ago, only to see 90% of the rank-and-file members of the union reject it in a ratification vote.

This is the nation's largest private-sector strike since the UAW waged a six-week strike against General Motors (GM) two years ago.

Work at all of Kellogg Co.'s U.S. cereal plants came to a halt on 10/5/21 as 1.400Tobacco Workers and Grain Millers International Union (BCTGM) workers went on strike. The strike includes Kellogg plants in Battle Creek, Michigan; Lancaster, Pennsylvania; Memphis, Tennessee; and Omaha, Nebraska.

The union and the Battle Creek based company have been at an impasse at the bargaining table for more than a year

Kellogg's workers are fighting against cuts to jobs, wages and benefits, and the expansion of the hated two-tier structure which forces new hires to labor for less pay than their co-workers on the same line.









